on Supplies Contracts



Introduction

This paper sets out a suggested list of actions for public sector bodies when applying the social value points approach on Supplies contracts as part of the award criterion.

The following resources will support commissioners and procurement teams to identify the most relevant social value themes, indicators and initiatives for a specific contract:

- Procurement Policy Note (PPN) 01/21 (Scoring Social Value).

The Social Value Points approach is the default approach for Supplies contracts where the estimated contract value is greater than £250,000 per annum per supplier.
