

#### **Scoring Social Value**

Checklist for including

Social Value Alternative Approach

on Supplies Contracts



#### Introduction

This paper sets out a suggested list of actions for public sector bodies when applying the social value alternative approach on Supplies contracts as part of the award criterion.

The following resources will support commissioners and procurement teams to identify the most relevant social value themes, indicators and initiatives for a specific contract:

- Procurement Policy Note (PPN) 01/21 (Scoring Social Value).
- Scoring Social Value Guidance for Supplies Contracts
- Scoring Social Value e-learning module<sup>1</sup>
- Model award criteria for alternative approach on Supplies Contracts

The Social Value Alternative approach is the default approach for Supplies contracts where the estimated contract value is <u>less than</u> £250,000 per annum per supplier.
